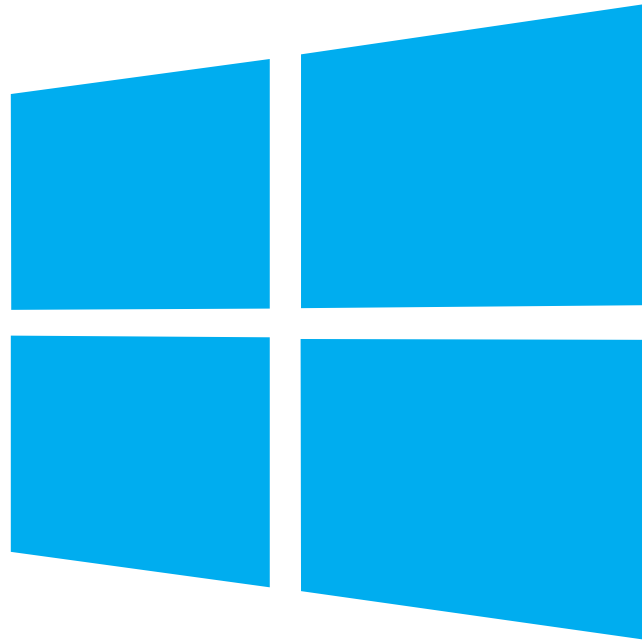

CMD commands

cls	Clear console screen
date	Display current date
time	Display current time
ver	Display windows version
hostname	Display hostname, will only work if CMD is open in administrator mode
cd directory_name	Open directory
cd..	Close the current working directory
md directory_name	Create new directory
rd directory_name	Used to delete the directory
del file_name	Used to delete a file
ren old_file_name new_file_name	Used to rename a file
copy file_name path_location	Used to copy a file to a particular location
move file_name path_location	Used to move a file to a particular location
copy con file_name file_content ctrl + z	Used to create a file with content in it

CMD commands

type file_name	Display all the contents of the file
color	The color command is used to change the colors of the text and background within the Command Prompt window.
dir	Display all the files and directories available in the working directory
xcopy	The xcopy command can copy one or more files or directory trees from one location to another

Linux commands

pwd	Display current path
cd ..	Close the current directory
cd directory_name	Open a directory
mkdir directory_name	Create new directory
rmdir directory_name	Delete the existing directory
Ls	List all the directories and files in the working directory
mkdir -p dir1/dir2/dir3	Create parent and child directory
rmdir -p dir1/dir2/dir3	Delete parent and child directory
